Sign and Seal:

SIGN

1) Signifies being washed of old sinful nature and given the new nature of Christ;

2) Allows us to publicly profess our faith, for ourselves and in God for our children;

3) Believers: Outward sign of inward transformation;

4) Children: Outward sign of child being included in covenant and church body.

SEAL

Mysteriously and powerfully marks that person as a part of the covenant, infusing grace blessings;

Not Salvation

If you aren't sure about babies...that's ok.

If you have never been baptized but know Jesus...

If you have, let this remind you of yours

Acts 21
